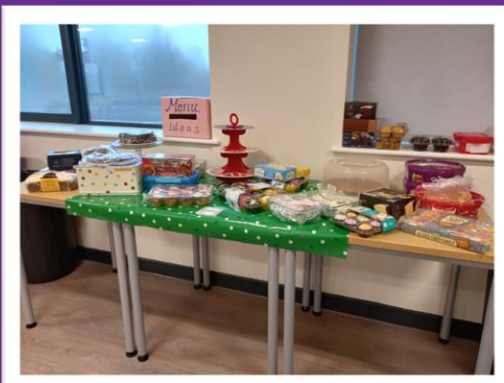
Thank you

Macmillan Coffee Morning

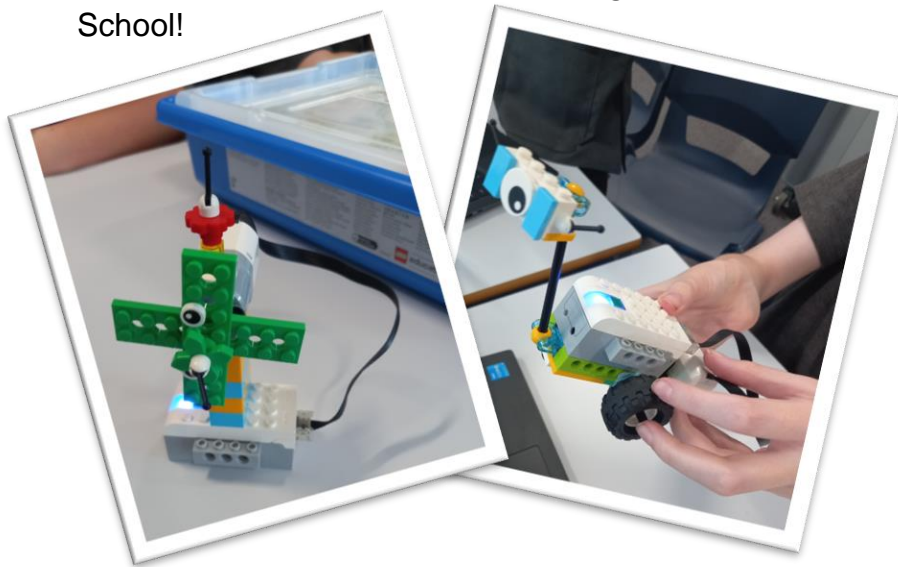

What's been happening?

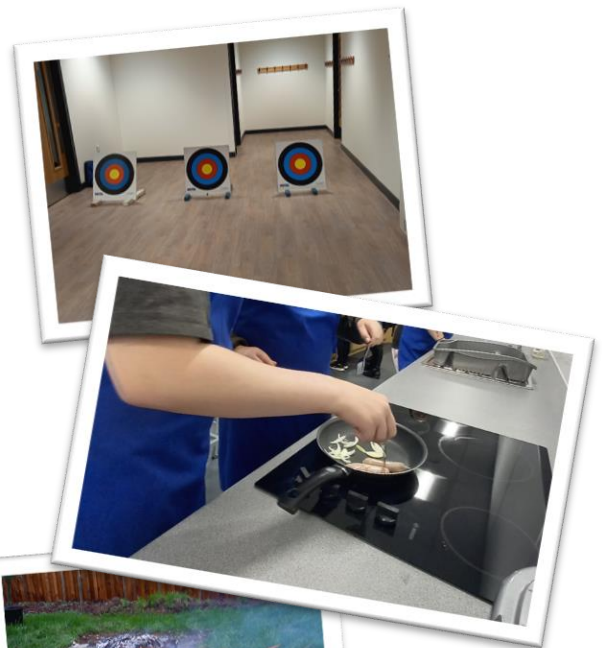
Lego Day
